Attorney Janine Bauer told Mayor Fernandes that on Wednesday, July 23rd the motion to appeal the Highland Bridge destruction was denied. The Sea Bright Governing Body fought this battle to the bitter end.

Mayor Fernandes said that Shore Regional High School will have a special school referendum on September 30th from 3 p.m. to 9 p.m. regarding the purchase of a new HVAC system and lighting for the school.
